Henderson State University Transfer Policy for BSN Students with a Prior ADN Degree 02-05-2021

BSN = Bachelor of Science in Nursing **ADN** = Associate Degree in Nursing

To qualify for the following transfer benefit, students admitted to the nursing program at Henderson State University (HSU) must have earned an ADN/Diploma (Associate of Applied Science in Nursing qualifies), as well as hold a valid RN license to practice nursing.

Nursing credit parameters for the progressing RN who graduated from an associate degree or diploma program that was NLNAC, CCNE or ACEN accredited; or Arkansas State Board approved at the time of graduation will be considered. Comparable international degrees will be considered on a case-by-case basis at the discretion of the HSU nursing faculty.

Nursing credits completed prior to matriculating at HSU will not be transcripted. Rather, qualifying students will be awarded a progression package of 41 credit hours in nursing as listed below.

The progression package provides 37 hours of upper division credit. Additional upper division credits needed to meet the minimum graduation requirement of 42 hours will be earned through the HSU nursing program.

Each fall and spring semester the nursing program will notify the registrar of incoming students. The registrar will ensure transcription of all prior non-nursing coursework from the awarded

ADN program at that time. The progression package (41 credit hours) will be transcripted during the final semester at HSU after a graduation application is approved by nursing faculty.
